



2023 NATIONAL QUIZ COMPETITION GENERAL GUIDELINES, RULES AND REGULATIONS

PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS (SIX)

1. There will be three rounds of the competition- Rounds One, Two and Three
2. There will be 5 questions for each Round;
3. Each question carries Five Points;
4. Participants have 30 seconds to answer questions, and this is counting from the moment the quiz master completes reading out the question;
5. Questions would be read once but may be repeated upon request;
6. Anytime there is a request to repeat a question, the computation of 30 seconds starts from the time the question was first read;
7. There is only one chance of attempting an answer for True or False questions;
8. Students may confer with each other and agree on their final answer;
9. No bonus questions for participating schools, they would go to the audience;
10. At the end of Round One, the school with the lowest score will be eliminated leaving FIVE schools to proceed to Round Two;
11. At the end of Round Two, the two schools with the lowest score will be eliminated, leaving the remaining Three schools to advance to the Third and Final Round;
12. The school with the highest score in Round Three will be the Top school and winner of the State Competition;
13. The computation of highest points in Round Three is strictly from the questions answered in the Round, and not a cumulative point score;
14. The winner of the State Competition automatically represents the State at the Zonal Level of the competition;
15. Teachers and other students are prohibited from answering or whispering answers;
16. Any violation will result in a caution in the first instance and disqualification subsequently. This is to be determined by the Quiz Master.
